A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Monday at the Lindsey Chapel Baptist Church with Paul and Susie

Luchsinger officiating and Tim Turner assisting. Funeral arrangements are under the direction of Hunn, Black & Merritt Funeral Service of Eufaula.

Born May 28, 1959, in Holdenville, to Roy and Elizabeth Fisher, he graduated from Eufaula High School in 1978, and went to Oklahoma Christian University on a baseball scholarship. He graduated from OCU in 1983, with a Bachelor's Degree in Business. On June 22, 1985, he married Judy Menasco at the Fisher Ranch. He was involved with ranching, horses and working with cattle. He was the head of the Fisher Ranch Team that competed in the Annual Oklahoma Cattleman's Association Range Round-up.

Survivors include his father, Roy Fisher and wife, Glenna, of Eufaula; mother, Elizabeth Fisher, of Tulsa; son, Jonas Fisher, of Coweta; daughter, Sara Fisher, of Coweta; brothers, David Fisher and wife, Patty, of Eufaula, Chris Fisher and wife, Donna, of Tulsa and Gary Fisher and wife, Lynn, also of Tulsa, and sister, Ann Robbins and husband, John, of Eufaula.
